DESCRIPTION OF THIRD AGE AND FAILTE ISTEACH:

THIRD AGE

The primary target group of the Third Age is older people, and part of the ethos involves a focus on providing information and new ideas that will encourage older people to improve their own lives, and make a positive difference to their communities through their actions.

THE FÁILTE ISTEACH PROJECT

Fáilte Isteach, a national project which utilises the skills, talents and commitment of volunteers, was established in October 2006 in response to the challenges experienced by migrants and refugees in Ireland due to their lack of English language skills. This initiative involves predominantly older volunteers welcoming migrants to the community through conversational English classes. Following its inception in Summerhill, Co Meath the project was launched nationally in 2008. To date Fáilte Isteach has opened 198 branches in 26 counties involving over 2500 volunteers tutoring approximately 5500 migrant and refugee learners each week.

> Support groups nationwide in establishing an effective and sustainable Fáilte Isteach branch in their community;

Deliver induction and training workshops to new tutors;

> Stay informed as to the relevant skills that tutors will require for effective delivery of the Fáilte Isteach project, including additional training;

> Seek regular feedback from tutors and students and develop, enhance and improve the project based on their observations and comments;
